

Island of Flowers (Ostrvo Cvijeca)

The size of the island is small - about 300 m long and 200 m wide. It is officially called an island, but it is more precisely a peninsula, since it is connected to the mainland by a small overhang. And only during the high tide does this part of the country flood a little and, accordingly, Miholjska Prevlaka resembles an island. The island is considered the birthplace of all types of palm trees, various flowers and plants that developed in the old days. However, the numerous and varied wildlife, lush Mediterranean greenery, flowers will still satisfy tourists. The Island of Flowers beach is 1200 m². It is 2 km from Tivat. What makes this island attractive in history is the complex - the remains of the Monastery of St. Archangel Michael. Near the church on the east side in the XIX century. church of Sv. Trojice built by the countess Ekatarina Vlasteleinovic. This is one of the most significant natural and cultural - historical entities. After five meters of shallow sea, this island extends to the Brda peninsula. Flower Island - is the first of three islands in a unique series of islands in the Bay of Kotor, Tivat Bay, known as the Krtoljski Archipelago.
