The long sandy beaches of the town of Nin are one of its trademarks and an impressive image that is remembered by all who have stayed on them at least once. Therefore, it is not surprising that many of them are among the most beautiful in Croatia and in the world. According to the choice of the American Travel Channel, Queens Beach is included among the 100 most beautiful beaches in the world. A beautiful legend is connected with the famous Queens Beach - Croatias longest sandy beach. The wife of the first Croatian king Tomislav, says the legend, was especially attracted by her beauty, so the royal family, whenever they officially stayed in royal Nin, visited this beach and enjoyed it in rare relaxed moments. The Queen's Beach has three entrances. It is interesting that at the entrance I. A beach about ten meters long should be crossed across the beach to the coast, so the so-called baby beach because of the shallow and warm and here come families with small children. Along the sandy beach there are four Natura 2000 habitats, and one habitat covers the largest locality of medicinal mud (peloid) in Croatia. Entrance II. used by bathers by those who come to organized peloid therapy during the summer months in the Eco Spa. The winds in the Nin Lagoon make this area ideal for surfing and kiting, so entrance III. in addition to tourists, it is most often used by wind lovers - kites and surfers. The total length of Nin beaches is 8000 meters, and the total length of sandy shores that stretch in the Nin Riviera is as much as 30 km ..
